



WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN IT COMES TO THE SAFETY OF YOUR CAMPER

We're committed to the safety of your child, our staff, and the ability to have fun and grow in a nurturing and safe environment.

HEALTH & SAFETY SPECIFICS

Staff training: Our teams undergo a comprehensive camp training program that involves both in-person and online learnings. We conduct criminal background checks to ensure trustworthy staff and passionate teachers provide the best care and education for your child.

Outdoor and field trip safety: All outdoor play is supervised and only conducted on safe, secure outdoor play spaces available on campus or at the program location. Staff are regularly trained in safety measures related to field trips or off-site activities. Outdoor play and field trips will also depend on inclement weather such as heat advisories and air quality. Families will always need to provide permission before a child participates in a field trip or off-site activity.

Water safety: Certified lifeguards will be present during swimming and boating activities; a detailed waterfront safety plan is in place, and each camper will be administered a swim test to determine swimming abilities.

Emergency response plan: Each camp location is equipped with an emergency response plan that highlights evacuation, local emergency phone numbers, and a parent communication plan.

Health screenings: Children will be monitored daily. If your child doesn't feel well or starts to show symptoms while in our care, we will notify you right away and take appropriate measures.

Allergies and dietary restrictions: Information will be gathered during enrollment and site-specific allergy lists created, maintained, and made available in each camp group. These lists are updated monthly, or as new campers enroll. Our teams are trained on how to identify and care for an allergic reaction.

Medication management: Medication is stored in a secure location accessible by trained camp counselors.

Parental consent and medical forms: Accurate and up-to-date medical and consent forms must be completed before the camp session begins.

Camp policies and behavior expectations: We are committed to fostering a safe and respectful environment, and partner with parents to provide a positive and secure camp experience.

Sunscreen & bug spray: We're all about safe fun in the sun. We'll make sure to slather on sunscreen and bug spray as needed to keep those adventures bite-free and sun-kissed.

Pickup and drop-off: We strictly follow established procedures for your child's arrival and departure: All children must be signed in and out on our paper-based roster and/or computer system, in addition to other individual state licensing regulations. Only pre-approved people with photo identification may pick up your child from our program.
